THE FOLLOWING ITEM HAS BEEN ADDED TO SECTION IV. INFORMATION FOR OFFERORS TO SUBMIT OF THE SOLICITATION:

In their proposals, Offerors shall provide specifications for processing a 4K input signal on two HD-SDI connections from an AJA Kona 3G I/O card.

THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS WERE RECEIVED FROM A VENDOR:

QUESTION: Will you consider modifying your Indemnity language to limit it to the sole negligence or willful misconduct of Vendor and its direct subcontractors and exclude owner's negligence?

ANSWER: While the University has considered your request, it has decided not to modify the Indemnification – Third Party Claims clause in Section VII Terms and Conditions – B. Special of the solicitation .

QUESTION: Will you consider adding clear standards for substantial completion and final acceptance?

ANSWER: While the University has considered your request, it has decided not to add additional/revised standards for substantial completion and final acceptance by the department for the contract. Please refer to the payment and Interest clause in Section VII Terms and Conditions – A. General of the solicitation.

QUESTION: Will you consider agreeing that disputes will be settled by arbitration or in a specified court?

ANSWER: While the University has considered your request, it has decided not to modify the Disputes clause in Section VII Terms and Conditions – A. General of the solicitation .

QUESTION: Will you consider adding language under "Default" that would provide that Vendor shall either cure the failure within 10 days or submit an acceptable plan to cure?

ANSWER: While the University has considered your request, it has decided not to modify the Default clause in Section VII Terms and Conditions – B. Special of the solicitation .

QUESTION: We would not expect a contract of this nature to be auto-renewing. Can you confirm that you will provide a method for Vendor to opt-out of auto-renewing if desired?

ANSWER: While the University has considered your request, it has decided not to modify the Term of Contract – Option to Renew clause in Section VII Terms and Conditions – B. Special of the solicitation .
