THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS WERE RECEIVED FROM A VENDOR REGARDING THE SOLICITATION:

QUESTION #1: Is the current version of WorkEngine 4.1 in an EPMLive hosted environment or on-premise?

ANSWER: On premise.

QUESTION #2: What is the current state of the 4.2 environment? Please provide as much detail as possible on:

- a. Number of servers?
- b. What has been installed to date?
- c. Virtual or physical servers?

ANSWER: a. **Three (3) virtual servers (DB, APP, WEB).**
b. **Installed WorkEngine 4.2.3 in current QA environment – it's not functioning properly. We have worked through several issues and will continue until it runs without errors.**
c. **Virtual servers.**

QUESTION #3: Is the new environment intended to be a migration target for production going forward or for QA only?

ANSWER: It is intended to be QA and Production going forward.

QUESTION #4: Are you considering an in-place upgrade in the current environment (4.1) once the QA installation is complete?

ANSWER: Once QA and PROD environments are established on the NEW servers we will be uninstalling WorkEngine from our CURRENT QA and PROD environments. At this point the new environment will be for WorkEngine and PortfolioEngine ONLY and the current environment will be SharePoint only.

QUESTION #5: Are you interested in formal training (classroom / lab) as well as quick-train sessions?

ANSWER: We would be interested in pricing for both and what they entail.

QUESTION #6: How many users do you currently have using the production system? By system role? (Project Managers, Team Members, Administrators)

ANSWER: We currently have Two hundred and five (205) users using the production system. By system role: Fifteen (15) Project Managers, One hundred and eighty seven (187) Team Members, and Three (3) Administrators.
