Answers to Questions

1. Could you please provide a copy of the most current monthly and annual commission reports specifying the locations of equipment, commissions per machine paid by vendor for the past three years?

ANSWER: We have included detailed information by location for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 as a representative for revenue by machine location. This information is included on Page 5 of this amendment.

2. Please provide the current rate of commission received?

ANSWER: The University is currently receiving 18% commission based upon annual sales of \$300,001 to \$400,000. The contract commission rates based upon sales are as follows:

up to \$300,000	17%
\$300,001-\$400,000	18%
\$400,001-\$500,000	21.5%
\$500,001 and over	25.5%

3. Can you provide us with any corporate sponsorship or additional incentives that may currently be received?

ANSWER: There are no corporate sponsorships or additional incentives received under the current contract. Occasionally, the current contractor provides snack products at no cost to the University to promote things like healthy snack vending and other healthy eating events at the University. This is provided strictly on a voluntary basis.

4. What is the current vending machine pricing by product and location?

ANSWER: Current pricing for items stocked in machines:

- Wheat Chips (Baked and Regular)= \$1.00
- Potato Chips (Baked and Regular) = \$1.00
- Pretzels = \$1.00
- Cheetos (Baked and Regular) = \$1.00
- Corn Chips = \$1.00
- Snack Mix = \$1.00

- Wheat and Cheese Crackers in a pack= \$0.75
- Trail Mix = \$1.25
- Healthy Bars (nuts, fruit, grain or raisin)= \$1.00

- 5. What is the current contract term?

ANSWER: The current contract began on July 1, 2005 and expires on June 30, 2015.

6. Is the proposed contract term negotiable?

ANSWER: No.

7. Can you provide us with name of the current snack vending, beverage vending and food service provider and any applicable contract terms?

ANSWER: The current snack contractor is Compass/Canteen, the drink vending contractor is Coca-Cola, and the food/dining service contractor is Sodexo.

The contract terms are:

Snack vending with Compass/Canteen to June 30, 2015. Drink vending with Coca-Cola: Aug. 1, 2011, to July 31, 2018 Food service/dining with Sodexo: July 1, 2002, to June 30, 2017

8. How often has the current vendor(s) requested a price change in the past two years?

ANSWER: Once, to add larger bag snacks that required a higher vended price.

9. Are there any special nutritional requirements?

ANSWER: We require some Gluten free snacks as well as healthy snacks (Section 3.4) in the vending machines. Additionally we require snacks to be labeled in reference to nut allergies.

10. Are there any competing venues (convenience stores, markets, retail) that directly compete with vending?

ANSWER: The University bookstore and some dining locations on campus also sell snack items.

11. Is any preference given to minority or disadvantaged vendors?

ANSWER: Currently state law does not provide for a preference for minority or disadvantaged vendors.

12. Can you say how many people use the machines annually?

ANSWER: ANSWER: Approximately 53,445 patrons from January 2014 through December 2014.

13. Can you please explain how the rating system/process used in the awarding of this RFP will measure/recognize the value of brand new equipment with latest technology proposed vs value of "like new" equipment?

ANSWER: The University will accept either new or "like new" equipment. The evaluation criteria where this factor may effect the rating system or points allocated to the proposal could be evaluation criteria 4.3.1.5 if the technology that is proposed will enhance the proposed plan for increasing snack vending revenues.

14. Are there specific nutritional criteria that must be met to be considered as "healthy offerings" (understanding that a minimum of 1/3 of selections within the machine must be "healthy")?

ANSWER: 35-10-35

No more than 35% fats, 10% saturated fat, 35% sugar and less than 300 mg sodium and one serving size.

15. Please provide the annual revenue by machine for the satellite campus locations.

ANSWER: The satellite campuses in this RFP do not have a contract for snack vending machines.

16. Under 7. Terms & Conditions- B. Special PRICE ADJUSTMENT LIMITED AFTER INITIAL TERM ONLY PLEASE define "initial term" in the statement "Prices shall not be increased during initial term".

ANSWER: This clause in only applicable when annual renewals of a contract period are allowed for in a solicitation. This solicitation is being awarded as a 7-year maximum contract term.
