ADDITIONAL ATHLETIC SITES AND LANDSCAPING SERVICES AND WORK ADDED TO CONTRACT

The University reserves the right to add, delete, revise or expand Athletic Sites, landscaping services and other work to the contract in response to changing requirements. Such modifications will be executed using a written contract amendment with adjustments to contract amounts.

THE FOLLOWING QUESTION WAS RECEIVED FROM VENDOR A:

QUESTION: Will the awarded contractor be responsible for cutting Athletic fields?

ANSWER: The contractor is only responsible for mowing landscape areas. Athletic fields are not included in the contractor's scope of work.

THE FOLLOWING QUESTION WAS RECEIVED FROM VENDOR B:

QUESTION: Would you please provide the acreage/sq footage of turf and beds at each site? This will help in calculations of chemicals.
