This Amendment No. 1 modifies the IFB only in the manner and to the extent as stated herein.

## ITEM ONE: CLARIFICATIONS TO QUESTIONS PRESENTED BY VARIOUS VENDORS

<u>Page 19 Qualifications Section:</u> Due to client confidentiality, we cannot provide a list of our private commercial customers, and would treat the University of South Carolina in the same confidential manner if awarded this contract. We are happy to provide a list of municipalities, public education, and/or government customers (those considered public information). Will those be satisfactory for this section?

Answer: Yes

2. Pages 31-34 Pricing Proposal: Since the exact volume of waste per service and exact number of haul are unknown for the 20 yard roll-off containers, we would like to clarify how to price these services. For all of the roll-off containers, you would have a haul charge at each service + volume of material for landfill/disposal costs + monthly rental of equipment. Can you break these charges out on the pricing sheet or would you like us to include ourselves for these containers?

Answer: In addition to monthly rental, we can re-do the bid price sheet to include the per haul charge for the 20 yd roll-off containers.

3. <u>Current Rates:</u> Can you provide a breakdown of current services and rates for this campus?

Answer: Is this ok since the current contractor is re-applying and others would then know their rates? If so, we currently have fewer containers and a smaller 6 yd container in Beaufort.

Beaufort	1 6yd container	\$240/month
Dining	1 8yd container	\$310/month
Facilities	1 8yd container	\$310/month
Dorms	2 8yd containers	\$310 ea/month

The 20 yd roll haul fee is \$145.00 plus a disposal fee based on the volume.

4. Is 10am an absolute for pickup?

Anwser: 10am is the preference, 3:30pm would be the absolute (end of Facilities operating hours)

5. If the 20 cu yd are "will call" how do we provide a monthly cost? Are we able to ask instead for a per pull price?

Answer: Same as #2.

6. Lastly, one asked if there was any leeway with the contract start date so that they would be able to give us new containers.

Answer No, If they want can they not give us old containers to start with and then swap them out as they are able.
