Question #1

Are the Certifications required (R2, E-Steward, etc)?

Answer

Yes.

Question #2

What models or type of equipment are normally disposed of?

Answer

E-scrap: CPU's, Monitors (crt and flat panel), TV's, Printers, Projectors, copiers, keyboards, mice, batteries, and miscellaneous small electronics. (See attachment).

Questions #3

What are the upcoming expected quantities each type or model?

Answer

We have no way of knowing what the quantities will be. We palletize the items as they come in. Once 24 pallets have been filled, the contractor will be contacted for a pick up.

Question #4

What was the last awarded bid amount?

Question #1

On page 16 D. Certifications. Do vendors need to have all 3 certifications? E-Stewart and R2 are basically the same certification by two different companies?

Answer

It is strongly preferred that the contractor possess all 3 certifications; however either E-Steward or R2 along with ISO 14001 will suffice.

Also I know the University has many locations. Do we need to pick up at all of them and will they all have 24 pallets before they call for a pick up?




