A. GENERAL:

- Question: Can a small white tile line be added to accommodate a break point between plaster installs in this dive pool? The Pebble finishes require more care and attention than the older marble finishes. A small tile line would allow for a better finish and much easier application.
 Answer: Yes, a 1'x1" or 2"x2" white tile screed lines can be installed to the dive pool. Please remove plaster white coat before installing tile. Submit tile sample to architect for review.
- 2. **Question:** When installing the racing tile lanes, can we install directly over the old tile lanes if the substrate is in acceptable condition?
 - <u>Answer:</u> NO. Please remove existing tile and replace with new tile for consistent pool competitive dimensions. This pool is a Certified NCAA competitive pool and the finish dimensions are required to be accurate per the bid documents.
- 3. Question: When chipping out the old plaster finish (All hollow spots and loose areas will be removed) if the existing plaster is in good condition, can these areas be left and bond coated over in lieu of chipping out entire existing plaster shell? We will be applying a bond coat to the entire existing shell before plaster. It bonds with old plaster as well as the Gunite shell.
 Answer: This would only be acceptable if the finish dimensions of plaster match flush with new tile, gutter and pool interior fittings.
