THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS WERE SUBMITTED BY VENDOR A:

QUESTION # 1:

The bid solicitation speaks to "Hardwood Mulch," which is exactly what we do. However, later in the document the verbiage turns to "Hardwood Bark Mulch" which is a different product. Using "bark only" is not advised because bark alone is very light and very buoyant, so there will always be a big issue with the product floating in beds during a heavy rain. In other words, hardwood mulch isn't buoyant. Bark is.

ANSWER:

Hardwood mulch is what we desire.

QUESTION # 2:

I don't see any mention in the document of a color preference. Should I assume the bid is for un-dyed(natural) material?

ANSWER:

Un-dyed mulch is what we desire.
