Q: Following up on the two questions that were mentioned in the meeting. Please clarify the clause on wood destroying organisms.

A: Wood Destroying Organisms - Inspections for wood destroying organisms are included as a part of the contract. Should wood destroying organisms be found in the buildings, the cost of remediation will be provided to the University and will be paid on a separate contract.

Q: In addition the clarification on fumigation.

A: substitute the phrase "appropriate treatment" for the word "fumigation".

Q: The last question, who is presently servicing your account and what are they charging for their services.

Q: Is there prior pricing available for this contract?

Q: One last question. Please define what an emergency service would be?

A: An emergency service would be one that cannot wait until the next day. Most typically that would be for a rodent or other animal sighted in a resident's living space
