THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS WERE RECEIVED FROM VENDOR A:

1. Please confirm that the directive that "all files should be attached individually in one message" means that all 15 pages, reflecting page 2, C. Information for Offerors to Submit, items 1 -7, should be in one Word/pdf document. I just want to be sure that the directive does not mean that each of the 7 required items are to be separate attachments totaling 15 pages altogether.

ANSWER: The instruction on page 3 under "E-mailed Submission" that "all files should be attached individually in one message" means the email should not contain any zipped/compressed files. The email can contain separate attachments.

THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS WERE RECEIVED FROM VENDOR B:

2. For examples of past work, do I submit ten "images" total or ten "examples" (with a few images) of each)?

ANSWER: You may submit <u>up to 10</u> completed examples of your past work. This can include more than one image per completed work. However, please be mindful of the limitation of 15 pages. If submitting digitally, remember the total size of all uncompressed files shall not exceed 10 megabytes.
