Description of Professional Services Anticipated for Project

The University of South Carolina is seeking the services of five (5) structural consulting firms to provide design services, including but not limited to renovations, repairs, maintenance and new construction for miscellaneous projects. Some work orders executed under this contract may require the firm to coordinate work with other University consultants (i.e., architects, engineers, inspection and testing firms, LEED consultants and others as needed) to complete the design for assigned projects. Experience working with state agencies preferred. Also, experience working on an "on call" or "as needed" basis preferred. At the discretion of the University, selected firms could be asked to provide services at any USC Campus. There will be no travel and/or meal reimbursement for projects within a 50 mile radius of the principal's office. Minority and small business participation is encouraged.
