Description of Professional Services Anticipated for Project:

The University of South Carolina will be selecting up to ten (10) architectural consulting firms to provide design services, including, but not limited to, renovations, repairs, maintenance, and new construction for miscellaneous projects. Some work orders issued under this contract may require the firm to coordinate the work of other University consultants (e.g. engineers, inspecting firms, LEED consultants, and others as needed) to complete the design of assigned projects. Experience working with state agencies preferred. Also, experience working on an "on call" or "as needed" basis is preferred. The University reserves the right to select several firms located in the proximity of regional campuses. At the discretion of the University, selected architects could be asked to provide services at any USC campus. There will be no travel and/or meal reimbursement for projects within a 50 mile radius of the principal's office. Local firms will be given preference. Minority and small business participation is encouraged.
