SAMPLE BUDGET JUSTIFICATION - CAS INTERNAL GRANT

Senior Personnel (\$12,778)

<u>Faculty, Sample</u>, will serve as the Principal Investigator (PI) for this CAS internal grant. He will be responsible for the planning and execution of the project, including reporting project results. He will also have the responsibility to oversee and mentor the student researcher. Two weeks of summer salary plus one course buyout for Spring 2024 is requested. Sample Faculty's 9-month base salary is \$95,000 – so summer ECOM for 0.5 summer months is \$5,278. The course buyout is included at the fixed CAS rate for internal grants (\$7,500).

Other Personnel (\$3,600)

Funds are requested to support one undergraduate student researcher to work part-time over the summer. We estimate \$15/hour for 240 total hours – the student will not be enrolled in classes during the summer months.

Fringe Benefits (\$1,978)

Fringe benefits are estimated based on USC guidelines (31.94% for senior personnel and 8.13% for the student researcher during the summer months). In accordance with the CAS Course Buyout Policy, fringe benefits are not separately charged for the Spring 2024 course buyout.

Travel (\$1,525)

Travel support is requested for the PI to attend and present at a national meeting in Sample City, State. Travel reimbursement will be in accordance with university policies, but cost estimates are provided below:
