A student entering with previous graduate-level work from another institution may be exempted from any of the core courses if the professor of the respective course verifies in writing that the student is qualified in the area (e.g., through background or testing). Such verification will be maintained in the student's permanent file. The student is responsible for requesting course exemptions (waivers) during the first semester of enrollment. Students who enter the program with a Master's Degree in another field must get a Master's in School Psychology from USC and may only get coursework waived, pending instructor approval. Students who enter the program with a Master's Degree in School Psychology or related field and do not wish to get a second MA from USC must complete a Research Project. Additionally, a Master's Oral Exam is not necessary.
