Loree Cook-Daniels has been working on both LGBT and aging issues since 1974. In the '90s she was a primary staff person for the National Center on Elder Abuse. She founded the Transgender Aging Network in 1998, and in 2000 became the Policy and Program Director for FORGE, a 27-year-old national transgender and SOFFA (Significant Others, Friends, Family, and Allies) organization that specializes in transgender aging and victims of violence. Formerly a contributing editor for the *Victimization of the Elderly and Disabled*, she has also authored numerous book chapters, articles and tip sheets on LGBT and trans aging issues. FORGE's Transgender Aging Network was a founding partner in the National Resource Center on LGBT Aging and remains its primary transgender expert. She holds a B.A. in Women's Studies and History, a M.S. in Conflict Management, and a Graduate Certificate in Trauma Counseling.
