

Ethel Sobel Brody Scholarship

2020 - 2021 Academic Year

History:

A native of New York City, Ethel Sobel earned a degree in Art with highest honors from Skidmore College in 1945. In 1947, she moved to Sumter, SC with her husband Reuben Brody and continued to study Printmaking and Art Education at USC before establishing a successful home decorations store in Myrtle Beach. In 1980, she moved to Columbia and served as an ardent and beloved supporter of the Columbia Museum of Art and the 701 Center for Contemporary Art.

The Ethel S. Brody Scholars Program Endowment Fund is established to recognize and support promising undergraduate students in Art Education at the University of South Carolina.

Eligibility: The Ethel S. Brody Scholarship is awarded to a rising Junior in Art Education who has shown unusual promise and commitment to art and teaching.

Award: The scholarship recipient will receive:

- a \$2,500 award in the Junior year
- a scholarship to participate in a summer workshop at Penland School of Crafts during the summer between the Junior and Senior years
- a \$2,500 award in the Senior year, contingent upon:
 - maintaining full time status as an Art Education major
 - maintaining a GPA of at least 3.0
 - continuing to exhibit promise and commitment to art and teaching
