Fascist regimes are products of postdemocracy. Fascist parties and their leaders come to power because they win elections in democratic countries. Fascists don't usurp power through coups or otherwise seize governments; they are elected by huge numbers of voters. Focusing on the Weimar Republic between 1924 and 1933, I shall try to explain exactly how Hitler and the Nazi Party managed to get themselves elected. What happened in Germany after 1933 needs little explaining
