In June 2022, the US Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade, which established a constitutional right to abortion. The ruling on Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization gives individual states authority to regulate abortion. Dr. Billings examines the larger global context- trends and actions taken by activists, health systems, and government entities around the world- to discuss next steps in the US context and pay particular attention to the Green Wave throughout Latin America.

Dr. Deborah Billings has worked globally on sexual and reproductive health, rights and justice, including access to safe abortion, contraceptive care, prevention of intimate partner and sexual violence, prenatal-birthing-postpartum group care for the past 35 years. She is an adjunct associate professor in Arnold School of Public Health's Department of Health Promotion, Education, and Behavior.
