



## Application for a Graduate Assistantship

All graduate assistantships positions are located in Columbia, South Carolina. Candidates must be admitted to the MLIS program to be eligible for consideration and must be able to be on campus at least three days a week or 10 hours per week.

The deadlines coincide with the MLIS application deadlines: November 15 for spring term and March 15 for summer and fall terms. It is important to submit your application even if you have not received an admission decision.
