## **Minimum Selection Criteria**

- Student must be a minority(African American, Native American or Hispanic)
- Student must be a rising high school freshman, sophomore, junior or senior
- Student must have a minimum overall (B) grade-point average (a few exceptions will be made for underachievers extremely high potential)

**NOTE:** Limited spots available for upperclassmen (rising sophomores, juniors and seniors)
