Comprehensive Evaluation:

- Vocational assessment and career exploration.
- WorkKeys® Career Readiness Certification
- Occupational therapy assessments of upper extremity strength, cognitive and visual skills, dexterity and activities of daily living.
- Residential services in a facility with accessible rooms, a dining hall and scheduled recreational activities to create a comfortable atmosphere.

Information Technology Training:

- Business Applications Plus
 - BAP prepares consumers for careers in customer service and office support. This includes instruction and hands-on experience in Business Communications, Keyboarding, Record Keeping (physical & electronic), as well as the MS Office Suite (Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Outlook), bookkeeping fundamentals using QuickBooks Pro and medical office administration.
- Computer Aided Drafting
 - CAD centers on the development of entry-level CAD technicians who are proficient in 3D CAD fundamentals, and mechanical and civil design applications.

 - NSS addresses the needs of industries for persons who are qualified to apply the basic concepts and fundamentals of PC, network, server support, and helpdesk. Consumers prepare for and have the opportunity to take the CompTIA A+, Network+ and Server+ certification exams.
