

Medical Aspects in Child Abuse Investigations (Virtual Trainings)

Overview: The Children's Law Center is offering focused presentations on various medical aspects of child abuse investigations. These presentations will be conducted by South Carolina Children's Advocacy Medical Response System (SCCAMRS) qualified child abuse pediatrics medical providers. Each presentation will cover the unique medical aspects of a different form of maltreatment, including physical abuse, sexual abuse, medical neglect, failure to thrive and medical child abuse. Medical experts will cover how to recognize the maltreatment, what should be documented, information that is needed to make a medical conclusion or diagnosis related to the form of maltreatment, red flags, and/or risk factors.
