



# Medicolegal Infant Death Investigations

**Who should attend:** Coroners, law enforcement, prosecutors, forensic medical professionals

**Overview:** This three-day course, offered to coroners, law enforcement, prosecutors, and forensic medical professionals in South Carolina, will focus on the responsibilities of investigating infant deaths. The training will include statistics, causes, and risk factors of unexpected infant deaths; the multi-disciplinary response and protocol; child maltreatment red flags and indicators; burns; abusive head trauma; blunt trauma fatalities; SUID, overlay, and homicidal asphyxiation; infant death scene documentation and processing; forensic toxicology; conducting parent interviews; anatomical dolls and scene reenactment; courtroom testimony; and case studies. These topics will be presented by experts from coroners' offices, SLED, and the SC Children's Advocacy Medical Response System.
