I hereby claim my seat in, and confirm my commitment to take part in, the 2019 School of Law Maymester courses entitled “Comparative Justice Systems” and “European Environmental Law” conducted at Gray’s Inn, London (the “Courses”). I understand that I am required to enroll in both Courses and that the academic content of the Courses is what would be expected of a 1½-credit-hour and a 2½-credit-hour classroom course, four credit hours in all. I also understand that my performance in the Courses will be measured by exams and class participation in both courses. I understand that the total tuition and fees for the Courses amount to \$5185. I have reviewed the London Maymester website. I have read this letter, and I understand and agree to its terms.

1. Request to Enroll and Commitment to Pay Tuition. I hereby request that the Law School Registrar enroll me in the Courses. I understand that the viability of the London Maymester program depends upon a binding commitment from me, on which the School of Law

can rely, to pay the Courses tuition and fees to the School of Law, and that such payment is due no later than six calendar days before the start of the Courses, which means that payment will be due no later than May 6, 2019.

2. Program Fee. Accompanying this form is a program fee in the amount of \$250, which I understand is non-refundable after February 4, 2019, unless the Courses are cancelled by the School of Law. (Checks should be made payable to the University of South Carolina.) I understand that my place in the Courses is not reserved until the program fee and this form, completed, are received by the Law School Registrar.

3. Obligations. I understand that, if sufficient students enroll to make the Courses financially viable, the School of Law agrees to present the Courses and, assuming my satisfactory completion thereof, award me the credits described above. The Courses will be presented at Gray's Inn, London, and will be supervised by faculty of the School of Law, at least one of whom will be present during the entire program. The School of Law will, with my cooperation, provide me with the letter required for me to obtain an appropriate visa to enter the United Kingdom as a short-term student. These are the only obligations of the School of Law. All matters as to international and local travel, lodging and other living arrangements, travel insurance (if desired), passports, meals, personal safety, and all other matters lying outside the obligations of the School of Law described above are my own responsibility. I understand that I will be automatically registered and enrolled in the University's overseas emergency medical insurance through Cultural Insurance Services International (CISI), and the associated charge of \$30 will appear on my student account. I understand that the School of Law and the University take no responsibility for my health care during the Courses. I agree not to seek to hold the School of Law, the University of South Carolina, Gray's Inn, or any agent or employee of any of them liable in respect of any cost, loss or injury relating to any item of my own responsibility as just described. I understand the nature, risks, and complications of international travel. I have had the opportunity to ask all questions that I deem material to engaging in the Courses and to carrying out the commitment made in this letter and have received satisfactory answers to such questions as I have asked.

I understand and agree that, if in the sole judgment of the faculty of the School of Law present in London during the Courses my comportment is such as materially to interfere with the presentation of the Courses or compromise the relationship between the School of Law and Gray's Inn, I will be discharged from the Courses, prohibited from attending Courses activities of any kind, and will forfeit the Courses tuition and fees and lodging fees.

4. Withdrawal from Program. **If I wish to withdraw from the Courses, I agree to provide written notice of my withdrawal from the Courses to the Law School Registrar by 5:00pm on February 4, 2019.**

5. In addition to the Courses, I expect (but understand that I am not committed hereby) to register for (choose one):

- A 2019 summer-school course of at least two hours' credit
- A research paper of at least two hours' credit

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REVISED HOUSING APPLICATION FORM

I have completed and signed a Commitment Letter and Registration form for the School of Law 2019 London Maymester program and have submitted it to the Law School Registrar together with my program fee of \$250. Its terms apply to this application.

I hereby apply for housing in London arranged by the School of Law. I understand that the housing consists of shared, twin-bedded bedrooms in a suite with a fully furnished kitchen and a bathroom, a sample of which is viewable on the program's website. I understand that the cost of the housing, for the duration of the program, may be as much as \$1,950 (cost will vary according to the \$/£ exchange rate at the time of payment and according to availability). Accommodations will be provided beginning on the night of Saturday, May 11, 2019, through and including the night of Thursday, May 30, 2019. If I wish, I can book additional days at additional cost directly with the landlord.

Attached, to secure my place, is my deposit of \$100, which I understand is non-refundable after February 4, 2019, unless the Courses are cancelled by the School of Law. (Checks should be made payable to the University of South Carolina.) The balance of payment for housing will be charged on my tuition bill. I understand that my housing registration is not complete and no space is reserved for me until my deposit and this form have been received by the Registrar. **I agree that if I have reserved lodging through the School of Law, I will be obligated, even if I do not attend the Courses, to pay the cost of the lodging unless the Law Registrar receives written notice from me of my withdrawal from the Courses by 5 p.m. on February 4, 2019.**

If I am particular about my roommate and/or suitemates I agree to make those arrangements myself with other participants in the program and to notify Heather Beatty, Director of Student Affairs, of such arrangements.

I understand and agree that I will be personally liable for any damage to my lodgings beyond ordinary wear and tear.

In making this application I have not relied on any oral or written representations other than printed materials given me by the Law School or appearing on the Law School web site.
