PR or PPR is a pre-requisite. A six credit hour course that meets for four hours per week. Enrollment is subject to the spring 2022 clinic lottery. If a student has taken a clinic course, then the student cannot take ICN. If a student has taken ICN, the student may enter the lottery for a clinic course. Students are limited to one clinical course while enrolled in law school. Students cannot enroll in an externship, capstone and clinical course in the same semester.
