11.6 – Student Access to Educational Records

Scope

University of South Carolina (USC) School of Medicine Greenville students

Policy Statement

Registration Hold – Per <u>USC ACAF 3.09</u>, every student is expected to discharge all obligations to the University as promptly as possible. Students who fail to meet their obligations to the University will not be permitted to register for classes.

Transcript and Diploma Holds - Per <u>USC ACAF 3.09</u>, No student or person duly authorized by the student shall be issued a copy of the student's transcript or receive verification, oral or written, of information contained therein, or be issued a diploma if the student is indebted to the university and/or if a student is in arrears or default on student loans, and/or if a student fails to participate in required assessment activities. However, requests for verification of enrollment will be given in circumstances required for student loans. The agreement for Title IV funds requires reporting by the institution.

Reason for Policy

This policy outlines the effects of outstanding requirements to USC or the USC School of Medicine Greenville or the partner health system at graduation or the change of semester and how to remove them.

Procedures

Clearing holds: Students must complete the outstanding requirements to USC, USC School of Medicine Greenville, and any affiliated institution, including the partner health system. For detailed information on reason for the hold, the student can request this information from the Registrar (registrar@greenvillemed.sc.edu). Upon completion of the requirement, the hold will be removed.

Sanctions

If a student does not complete all requirements, a hold is placed the student's registration, transcript or diploma.
