Scope

University of South Carolina (UofSC) School of Medicine Greenville students

Policy Statement

All UofSC School of Medicine Greenville students are required to have health insurance and disability throughout the duration of their education.

Reason for Policy

Student health and wellness as well as access to affordable healthcare.

Procedures

All students are required to maintain active health and disability insurance throughout their enrollment at the UofSC School of Medicine Greenville.

Student health insurance is automatically added to each semester's tuition bill. Students who have an equivalent/alternate health insurance plan may waive the university student insurance and its associated fee by submitting a fee waiver request and documenting proof of adequate medical insurance. Students must opt out of the student insurance each semester or it will be automatically billed to their tuition.

At matriculation, students are automatically enrolled in a third-party disability insurance plan; annual premiums are added as a fee to the fall semester tuition bill. The disability plan pays a monthly benefit if a student becomes disabled due to a qualifying event and includes a provision to pay off the student's loans (maximum of \$200K).
