#### Scope

University of South Carolina (UofSC) School of Medicine Greenville faculty, staff, and students

## **Policy Statement**

UofSC School of Medicine Greenville provides information technology resources for use by faculty, staff and students for University-related duties and responsibilities. The use of information technology resources for personal or other non-university purposes that results in costs to the university is strictly prohibited.

All users of University information technology resources must:

- Adhere to applicable state and federal laws, statues, and regulations
- Comply with applicable policies, standards and procedures
- Understand and acknowledge that information technology assets and data are for authorized use only
- Not compromise the availability, confidentiality, integrity, privacy or security of data, technology and user credentials.

#### **Reason for Policy**

To provide UofSC School of Medicine Greenville faculty, staff, and students clarity on the acceptable use of information technology.

#### **Procedures**

Faculty, staff, and students must follow the policies and procedures outlined in <u>UofSC Policy – UNIV 1.52</u> <u>Responsible Use of Data, Technology, and User Credentials</u> and Prisma Health Policy – S-025-04 Acceptable Use.

#### **Sanctions**

Faculty, staff, and students who violate the Acceptable Use of Information Technology Policy are subject to

disciplinary action up to and including dismissal.
