Submission Guidelines:

Eligibility: Submissions are open to School of Medicine Greenville medical students and faculty members.

Topics: We welcome abstracts on all topics related to medical research, including but not limited to:

- Basic Science Research
- Clinical Research
- Translational Research
- Lifestyle Medicine
- Public Health and Epidemiology
- Medical Education Research
- Healthcare Policy/Health Services Research

Structured Abstract Format:

- o Title
- Authors: Presenting students name first
- Affiliation: Include the department and institution.
- Background: Briefly describe the research question or problem.
- Methods: Outline the research design, methodology, and statistical analysis.
- Results: Summarize the key findings.
- Conclusion: Highlight the significance and implications of the research.

Submission Process:

- Abstracts should be submitted via the online <u>SUBMISSION PORTAL</u> by 11:59 pm on November 1st, 2024.
- The maximum word count is 300 words, excluding title, authors and affiliation.
- Figures and tables may be included within the word limit. (Limit to 1 of each in the abstract)
- Notification of Acceptance: **November 15th, 2024**

Presentation Formats:

- Poster Presentations: All accepted abstracts will be presented in a poster session. Posters will be due by 11:59 pm on December 1st, 2024.
- Oral Presentations: Selected abstracts will be invited for oral presentations.
 Presentation slides will be due by January 6th, 2025.

	 Does the design of the project appropriately answer the research question?

	 Are the results clear and related to the study purpose?

	• Is the conclusion relevant to the field and contributes to the field?

	Is the submission grammatically correct, free of typos, and
	coherent?
	 Are the ideas in the abstract clearly communicated?
	 Is it the appropriate level of complexity for the audience?
