You will have additional opportunities to serve as a teaching assistant or preceptor for the professional athletic training program.

Graduate Assistant Benefits

- 12-month Appointment: Starting June 1, 2025, and Ending May 31, 2026
- Compensation and Benefits Package: The *package* is offered between \$30,000-\$34,000 depending on clinical site. The package includes an out-of-state tuition waiver, full tuition coverage, healthcare coverage, and a biweekly stipend.
- Additional Earning Opportunities: Options to provide athletic training services for USC Athletics Summer Camps and community PRN events will offer additional pay.

Qualifications

To be considered, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- BOC certified by May 31, 2025
 - o This means you must take your BOC in the January or March/April 2025 testing cycle.
- Eligible for athletic training licensure in South Carolina
- Minimum graduate GPA of 3.0
- Admission to USC's Graduate School and enrolled in one of the Certificate Programs.
