Lucy Ingram, PhD, MPH, is an associate professor in the Department of Health Promotion, Education, and Behavior and the assistant dean of Academic Affairs and Online Education for the Arnold School of Public Health at the University of South Carolina. Her research is focused on addressing racial/ethnic health disparities in sexual and reproductive health. Dr. Ingram is Co-Lead of the Research Education Component for the CCADMR.



Daniela Friedman, PhD, is professor and chair of the Department of Health Promotion, Education, and Behavior at UofSC. She conducts interdisciplinary and partner-engaged research focused on health communication with racially and ethnically diverse older populations. Dr. Friedman is one of the principal investigators of the CCADMR and Co-Director of the UofSC Office for the Study of Aging.
