MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS

- Students who meet eligibility criteria are invited to apply
- Alumni and faculty can self nominate or be nominated
- Applications reviewed by selection committees
 - Separate committees for each membership type
 - Student committees: consist of current faculty of ASPH
 - Alumni/faculty committees: Mu Chapter Executive Board
- Each application is reviewed by **three** reviewers
- Disparate reviews are resolved by the Executive Board



INDUCTEES

- Students: total inducted $\leq 10\%$ of total graduating in relevant semesters
- Faculty: total inducted $\leq 3\%$ of total faculty or minimum of 2
- Alumni: total inducted ≤ 10



2020 INDUCTION TIMELINE

- Sunday, February 16 (11:59PM): Student applications due
- Sunday, March 8 (11:59PM): Faculty/alumni applications due
- By Monday, March 23: All offered induction will be contacted
- By Tuesday, March 31: RSVPs due for induction ceremony
- Tuesday, April 7, 2020 (4-5:30PM): Induction ceremony at Pastides Alumni Center
