Two lab visits during different hormone phases

· requires daily urine hormone testing



Nutrient challenge test:

- Drink a beverage with protein, carbs, or water
- · Multiple measures of:
 - o Body water
 - Muscle characteristics
 - o Energy expenditure
 - Nutrient metabolism



Time Commitment:

- Lab visits: 2 x 4 hour visits
- Total time in study: 1-2 months

Who We Are Looking For?

- Premenopausal women aged 18-40
- Naturally menstruating (21-35 day cycle)
- · Or using hormonal contraception
- Recreationally active (exercising ~3 d/wk)
- In good health

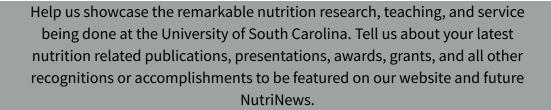
